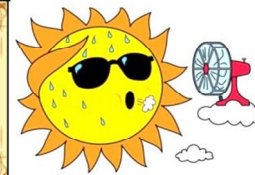
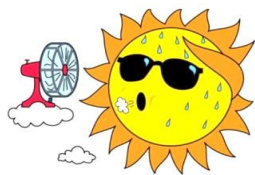

Shock and Awe (R)

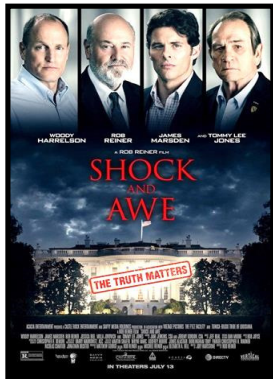
